Those who sold - John 2:14; **πωλέω** (poleo): to exchange or barter, sell. Matthew 10:29, 'Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin?'; 19:21, 'Jesus said to him, If you will be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor...'; 21:12, 'And Jesus went into the temple of God and drove out all those who bought and sold in the temple'; 25:9, 'but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves'; Mark 10:21 (see Matthew 19:21); Mark 11:15 (see Matthew 21:12); Luke 12:6 (see Matthew 10:29); 12:3, 'Sell what you have and give alms: provide yourselves money bags which do not grow old'; 17:28, 'Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot: they ate, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they built'; 18:22 (see Matthew 19:21); 19:45 (see Matthew 21:12); 22:36; John 2:14,16, 'And He found in the temple those who sold oxen and sheep and doves...and He said to those who sold doves...'; Acts 5:1, 'But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession'; I Corinthians 10:25, 'Eat whatever is sold in the meat market, asking no questions for conscience' sake.*

Moneychangers - John 2:14; **κερματιστής** (kermatistays): moneychanger, changing money into small coins. Only here in the Greek New Testament.

Money - John 2:15; **κέρμα** (kerma): small coin. Only here in the Greek New Testament.

Drove out - John 2:15; **ἐκβάλλω** (ekballo): cast, throw out, drive, expel. See parallel passages, Matthew 21:12, Mark 11:15, Luke 19:45. See also Mark 1:34, 'And He healed many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him'; 3:22, 'And the scribes who came down from Jerusalem said, He has Beelzebub, and by the ruler of the demons He casts out demons'; 16:9, 'Now when He had risen early on the first day of the week, He appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom He had cast seven demons';

House of Merchandise – John 2:16; **οἶκος ἐμπορίου** (oikos emporiou): **ἐμπόριον** is only used here; a trading place, merchant exchange. It is related to **ἐμπορία** (emporion) commerce, business, Matthew 22:5; and **ἐμπορος** (emporos) a merchant or passenger on a ship.
