John 5:18-23

His - John 5:18; ἴδιος (idios): one's own: of that which is private and personal. Luke 6:41, 'And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the plank that is in your own eye?'; John 1:11, 'He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him'; 5:43, 'I have come in My Father's name, and you do not receive Me; if another comes in his own name, him you will receive'; Acts 2:6, 'Now when this sound occurred, the multitude came together; and they were astonished, because everyone heard them speak in his own language'; Galatians 6:5, 'For each one shall bear his own load'.

Equal - John 5:18; ἴσος (isos) :equal, the same. Matthew 20:12, 'saying, These last men have worked but one hour, and you made them equal to us who have borne the burden and the heat of the day'; Mark 14:56, 59, 'For many bore false witness against Him, but their testimonies were not the same (equal)'; Luke 6:34, 'And if you lend to those from whom you hope to receive back, what credit is that to you? For sinners also lend to sinners to get back equal amounts'; John 5:18 (see below); Philippians 2:6, 'Who being in form of God did not consider the being equal things with God something to be grasped'; Revelation 21:16, 'And the city is laid out as a square, and its length is as great as its breadth. And he measured the city with the reed: twelve thousand furlongs. Its length, breadth, and height are equal.*

Shows - John 5:20; δείκνυμι (deiknumi): (see GNTSH February 24, 2008): to show, exhibit. Matthew 4:8; 8:4; Mark 1:44; 14:15; Luke 4:5; 5:14; 20:24; 22:12; 24:40; John 2:18; 5:20; 10:32; 20:20; Acts 7:3; I Timothy 6:15; Hebrews 8:5; Revelation 17:1; 21:9, 10; 22:1,8.

Gives Life – John 5:21; ζωοποιέω (dzoopoieo): to produce alive. To make alive, cause to live, quicken. John 5:21, 'For as the Father raises the dead and gives life to them, even so the Son gives life to whom He will.'; 6:63, 'It is the spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit and they are life'; Romans 4:17, '(as it is written, I have made you a father of many nations) in the presence of Him whom he believed, even God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did'; 8:11, 'But if the spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to our mortal bodies by His spirit who dwells in you'; I Corinthians 15:22, 36, 45; II Corinthians 3:6, 'who also has made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the spirit; for the letter kills, but the spirit gives life'; Galatians 3:21; I Peter 3:18.*
