Greek New Testament Curriculum

The Greek New Testament curriculum is designed so that students may gain the ability to read and study the Greek New Testament. The time invested in learning this tool for ministry will return a thousand fold in the blessings of delving into the scriptures in a way not possible without this ability.

The first year will concentrate on obtaining a basic knowledge of accident (the formation of words) and syntax (how the words function together in sentences). Within the First Year Greek New Testament, the student will also be introduced to the Greek New Testament text, textual criticism, and the use of a Greek concordance to study words in their context in the Greek New Testament.

The second year will concentrate on advancing the students' knowledge of syntax while reading the Greek New Testament and conducting exhaustive word studies. Discussions concerning textual history, evidence, and criticism will be integrated into the examination of the Greek text.

Upon demand, a third year will be offered in which books of the Greek New Testament will be read and studied in depth.

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
